What to see?

1. Look out for buzzards soaring in the sky as they begin to establish their territories. Buzzards are our most common bird of prey. They are large birds with broad round wings and they feed on small mammals such as rabbits and mice.
2. You will see beautiful, vivid purple, crocus flowers in gardens and parks this month. Crocuses are called light bulb flowers because they look like bright light bulbs, until the petals unfurl into a cup shaped flower.



To do:

1.  To attract birds to your garden, ask your family to help you **MAKE A BIRD FEEDER**.
2.  **FILL UP YOUR BIRD FEEDER** with seeds and suet balls bought from the shops, or make your own food for the birds. Sparrows like small seeds, blackbirds like maize, while tits and greenfinches like peanuts and sunflower seeds.
