## 3. Best 'Traditional' Building

## **Specific Criteria**

- A building of traditional local character, which contributes to the distinctiveness of the Chilterns, conserves and enhances the Area of
  Outstanding Natural Beauty, and is constructed using locally-produced building materials (e.g., clay tiles, bricks, flint, and timber etc.).
   The project should exemplify the application of the Chilterns Buildings Design Guide.
- Where applied to the conversion or alteration of an existing building, the outcome:
  - o recognises a best practice that has given a new lease of life to a traditional building by innovative and sympathetic reuse consistent with its historic or architectural significance; and/or
  - o demonstrates a responsible retrofit, whilst preserving the building's fabric and heritage, and exhibits quality energy solutions that enhance health and contribute towards the behavioural changes of occupants.
- Where applied to a new build, the project demonstrates an understanding of the built and natural fabric of its context in terms of layout,
   access and its position in the landscape.
- Whether a conversion or a new build, the project demonstrates excellent quality craft skills and the use of traditional materials, including salvaged or recycled materials.
