### 1 Chiltern Brewery

**2 Dark Old Ale, 2 Chiltern lager, 2 Dark Old Ale Chutney**

The oldest independent brewery in the region, with an enviable nationwide reputation. A family-run business in the heart of the Chiltern Hills at Terrick, the emphasis has always been on producing natural, wholesome beers using the best British malt and hops. Their excellent farm shop features a selection of products made using Chiltern beer, winners of a number of Great Taste Awards.

### 2 Chiltern Cold Pressed

**Gift pack of 5 flavoured rapeseed oils**

The Mead family have been farming in the Chilterns since 1860. They began making Chiltern Cold Pressed Extra Virgin Rapeseed Oil in 2009 and have since extended their collection to include a range of infused oils, salad dressings, sauces and marinades. Their oils have won many national food awards and have even featured in an episode of the BBC's *Escape to the Country*.

### 3 Chilterns Recipe Book

With more than 50 recipes, this book showcases the region's best ingredients and the people who lovingly

produce them. Set against the backdrop of the stunning Chilterns countryside, it celebrates the deep connection between our food, the people who produce it, and the land, and focuses on the area's food and drink scene.

### 4 Chiltern Ridge

'Pure 100% apple juice with nothing added' is the credo behind this Chartridge-based, family-run business. Their juice is available in many local farm shops. In addition to producing their own juice, they'll press your apples into a delicious, pasteurised juice. Their farm shop also sells pork and lamb. They even have B&B accommodation on site.

### 5 Chiltern Society

Inspired by the stunning Chiltern countryside, this selection of gifts and walking books should be part of every keen walker's collection.

### 6 Creative Juices Brewing Company

**2 gift packs with The Light Fandango and Part of Me Is You Pale Ale and beer glass**

This relatively new craft brewery is based at Woodoaks Farm in Maple Cross, at the north end of the Colne Valley. They're on a mission to produce outstanding beers, using the finest quality ingredients, while also supporting the creative arts. If you're looking to find beer perfection served with a friendly smile, their little brewery taproom is a great place to start.

### 7 Daws Hill Vineyard

**2 bottles of sparkling cider**

Christmas wouldn't be Christmas without a drop of something fizzy, and at DHV in Radnage they specialise in making it! Founded in 2004, they now produce a range of brut and rosé sparkling wine and an excellent bottle-fermented sparkling cider. International awards have included a bronze medal, won at the prestigious Effervescents Du Monde competition in France.

### 8 Dizzy Bee Kitchen

**Nourishingly Nutty Granola and Gluten-Free Pecan & Quinoa Granola**

Set up eight years ago by Nicky Halloran, DBK produces healthy, lower sugar granolas, which taste deliciously home-made. They're packed with nutritious, and where possible, locally sourced ingredients. A winner of 12 Great Taste Awards, Nicky still makes her granola by hand in her dedicated Granolery. She's now selling exclusively direct from her website!

### 9 Griffiths Brothers Gin

**2 x 10cl bottles of Gin**

A family-run distillery based in Penn Street. The two brothers aim to blend modern distilling methods with the craft of producing small batch spirits, using only the highest quality botanicals.

They intend to gradually extend the range of different gins they offer.



### 10 Horsebox Coffee Co.

**3 packs of ground coffee – Dark Horse, Brightstar and Delicious Decaf**

HCC has its own roastery based on a quiet working farm in South Oxfordshire. They source sustainably cultivated green coffee from individual farms and cooperatives. Using the latest roasting technology, they consistently develop each coffee's unique character. Alongside their much-loved signature blends from ethical farmers and cooperatives, they also offer an evolving range of seasonal, single estate speciality coffees.

### 11 Hundred Hills Wine

**Magnum – Doe Eyed Queen**

Doe Eyed Queen is an English sparkling wine collection combining beautiful boutique wines with a real celebratory style. They're wines created at a tranquil family-owned winery located in the heart of Oxfordshire, where precision in winemaking has been followed at every stage. These vegan wines are some of the first English wines produced inside a winery accredited to the highest levels of sustainability by WineGB. The winemaking is minimalist in style, looking to bring out naturally the complexity and intensity of the flavours and aromas inherent in the grapes of the family's vineyards.

### 12 Jim and Jules Big Adventure

**1 jar of Beetroot & Spiced Orange Relish chutney, a jar of Pops' Perfect Piccalilli, and a jar of Morning Sunshine Marmalade**

This husband and wife team has been making chutney since 2008. Their 'big adventure' began when they needed to raise money to fund their wedding, and chose chutney-making because Jim's parents had a massive apple tree on their farm! From these unusual beginnings, they now make a range of delicious chutneys, piccalilli and preserves.

### 13 Kado – The Gift & Home Store

**2 handwashes from Kew and matching hand sanitiser**

Opposite their existing Princes Risborough high street shop, they're displaying giftware, homeware and collectables from the sought-after Wrendale Designs (the first of its kind in the UK), featuring an array of countryside and zoology wildlife-themed art drawn by Hannah Dale. Wrendale is an award-winning publisher of greetings cards, stationery and giftware with wonderful watercolour designs.

### 14 Marlow Cheeses

**1 Bisham, 2 Cygnet cheeses**

Reputed to be Buckinghamshire's first ever cheese maker, Marlow Cheese was launched in 2016. Cygnet, Bucks Blue and Regatta are their flagship products, all made using delicious whole milk from Laceys Farm. Now sold at many leading farm shops, including Peterley Manor Farm, and at Rebellion Brewery, its cheeses have even been spotted on the menu at Michelin-starred local restaurant, The Hand & Flowers.

### 15 Marlow Gin

**2 Bottles of Marlow Gin**

The gin is hand-produced by a small, friendly

team in their little distillery in Marlow. After spending 12 months building it and developing the recipe, they're proud to introduce to you their quality, small batch, hand-crafted gin dedicated to the town. Marlow Signature Gin has been awarded a Silver Medal at the International Wine and Spirits Competition.

### 16 Nettlebed Creamery

**Organic soft cheese**

NC produces three multi award-winning organic cheeses as well as organic milk, kefir, cream and ice cream using milk from Merrimoles Farm in Bix. A fully organic operation since 2001, the farm's cows graze on grass and clover leys enhanced with herbs. Their cheeses include Bix, a soft white rind cheese; Highmoor, a wash rind cheese and Witheridge in Hay, a semi-hard, alpine-style cheese.

### 17 No 2 Pound Street

**1 jar of Pound Street Pickle and**

**1 jar of Rhubarb, Apple & Fig Chutney**

This highly successful brewery was established in 1993 to ensure the continuation of

traditional brewing in Marlow after the closure of Wethereds. Since then, Rebellion have gone from strength to strength, winning numerous regional awards. Their ales are widely available in many local pubs and in their on-site Tap Yard, which serves their full range, alongside wines and ciders. Takeaway draught and bottled beers, as well as wine, cider, and artisan produce, can be bought from the well-stocked brewery shop.

### 22 Rumseys Handmade Chocolates

**Bag of Chocolate Mint Leaves and £5 voucher**

Master chocolatier Nigel Rumsey has been making delicious artisan chocolate since 1991. He owns two delightful chocolateries/cafés in Wendover and Thame, where you can choose from the wonderful selection of truffles, ganaches, pralines, creams and petit fours – each with their own distinctive flavour.

### 23 Salty Dog

Their products are gluten-free.

### 26 Tring Brewery Co.

**3 bottles of Alchemist beer and beer glass**

Winners of The Good Pub Guide's Brewery of The Year for 2019 and our 2017 Chiltern Craft Beer of the Year award, the brewery have been making beer for over 25 years. Well established at Dunsley Farm, they're known for their unusually named beers, which all have strong connections with events, myths and legends from the surrounding Chilterns. Their beers are available from the brewery shop and many good local pubs.

### 27 Twee Jam

**2 jars of Christmas Chutney**

Their range of jams, chutneys, vinegars and sauces use home-grown produce. This ensures the fruit and vegetables are picked, cooked and jarred in a day. The flavour levels and freshness are amazing, and the food miles are kept down too. If they have to buy ingredients in, they use sustainable, local suppliers and produce grown in Britain wherever possible.
