

Overview

The original Chiltern Way passed through the car park of the Old Watermill and reached Barton-le-Clay by walking across the A6 dual-carriageway. The new route heads south and uses the Sharpenhoe Road bridge.

Route Description

14: Old Watermill

Coordinates: OSGB TL07623119 LatLon 51.9688,-.4348

Instead of entering the car park of the Old Watermill, turn right and walk between trees and the fence of the Watermill. Shortly after the fence on the left ends you reach a footbridge. Cross the stream then turn right and continue along the stream. When you reach the point where the stream comes out of a concrete conduit, recross the stream and climb a set of steps up the embankment to the Sharpenhoe Road. Turn left and follow the road over the A6 dual-carriageway into Barton-le-Clay. You reach the Royal Oak Pub at a mini-roundabout. Cross right to the pub.

15: Barton - Royal Oak

Coordinates: OSGB TL08143088 LatLon 51.9660,-.4273

Cross the Luton Road and turn right along Bedford Road to continue on the Chiltern Way
