

Overview

The route of the Chiltern Way has changed: instead of dropping down to the outskirts of Aldbury and back up again it heads South and then West through the woods to Tom's Hill. NB: If you wish to visit Aldbury, the old route is still waymarked.

New Route Description

- (3) Turn left here on a footpath which soon joins a track past a cottage. Cross straight over the Toms Hill Road and continue for another 300m.
- (2) Turn right onto a crossing footpath and soon after fork left. Take care here if you miss the fork you will end up back at the road. For the next 750m you will be walking West, often near the edge of the wood. There are lots of other paths, so keep an eye out for the Chiltern Way disks on waymark posts.
- (1) You emerge from the woods by the brick wall around Tom's Hill house. Turn left on the road past the house.
