

Overview: From 2023 the route of the Chiltern Way in the North East of the Chilterns has changed. The route now runs from Sharpenhoe Clappers to Peters Green via Barton, Offley, Preston and Whitwell – a total of 29 miles. The route is fully waymarked – NB many of the fingersigns say “Chiltern Way Extension” or “North Chiltern Trail”. There is an overview map on the next page.

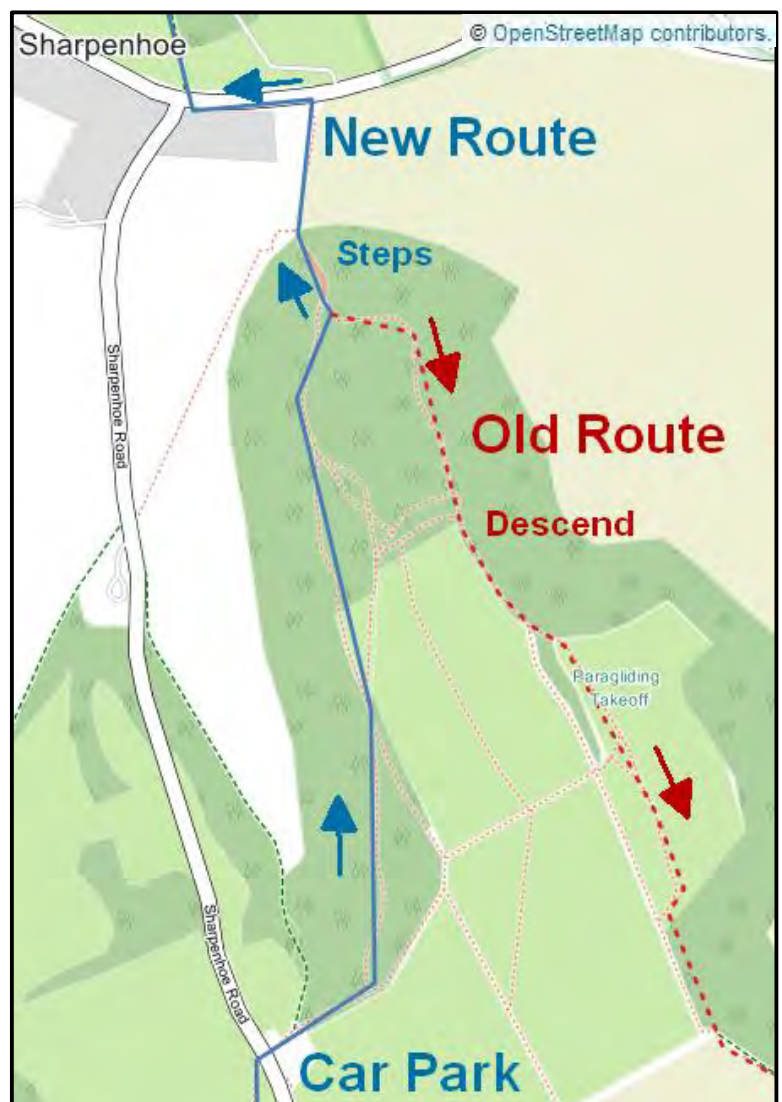

You can still follow the old route direct from the Clappers to Peters Green via Streatley, Lilley and Breachwood Green – a distance of 16 miles.

Route Notes – From the Clappers

Follow the Chiltern Way to the North end of the Clappers promontory. The **new route** takes the long flight of steps down from the top to Sharpenhoe village.

The **old route** continues around the woods at the top of the hill. Near the south edge of the woods descend steeply over tree routes. Now follow the path at the East side of the ridge to Streatley.
