Route Change

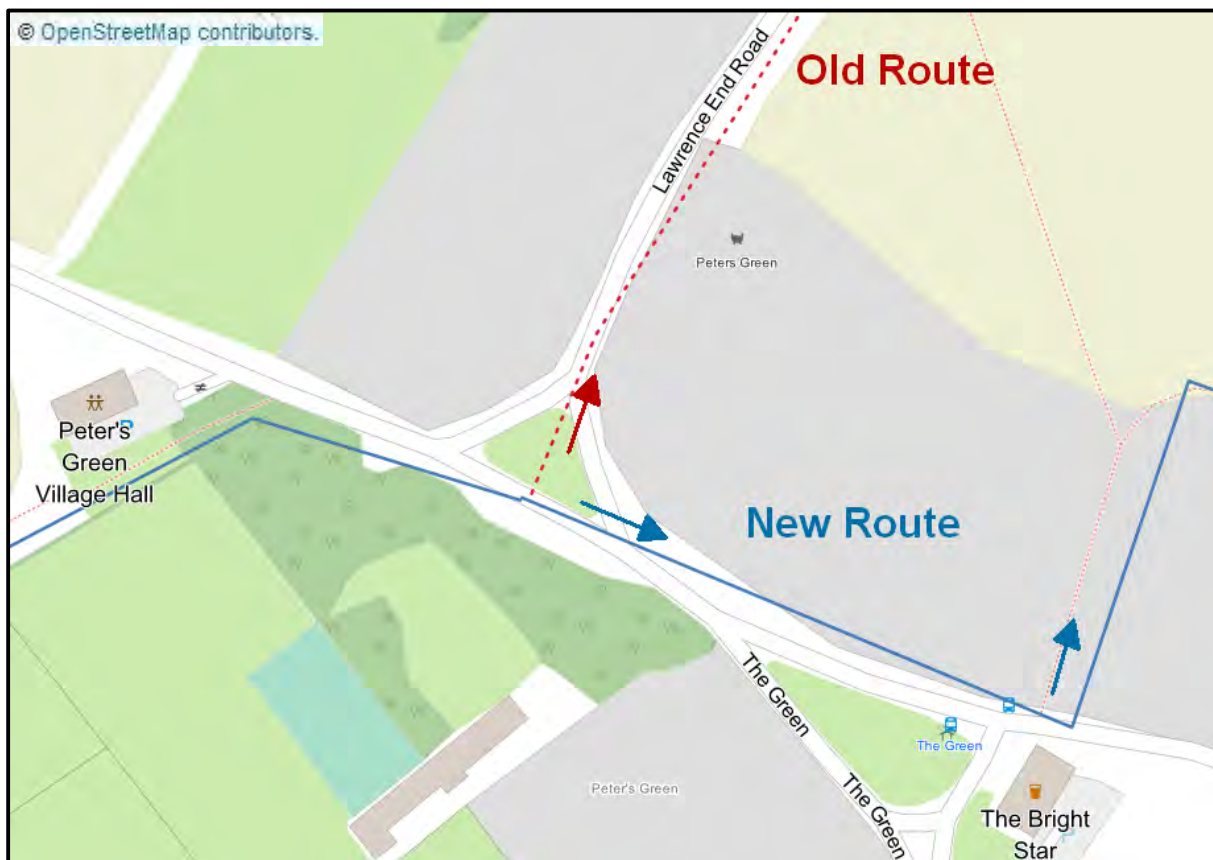
Overview: From 2023 the route of the Chiltern Way in the North East of the Chilterns has changed. The route now runs from Peters Green to Sharpenhoe Clappers via Whitwell, Preston, Offley and Barton – a total of 29 miles. The route is fully waymarked – NB many of the fingersigns say “Chiltern Way Extension” or “North Chiltern Trail”. There is an overview map on the next page.

You can still follow the old route direct from the Peters Green to Sharpenhoe Clappers via Breachwood Green, Lilley and Streatley – a distance of 16 miles.

Route Notes – From Peter’s Green

From the Village Hall, head right along the road towards the Bright Star pub. The **new route** turns left on a footpath near the pub. For the **old route** turn first left on the Lawrence End road towards Wandon Green.
