PPE

Safety glasses
Hi-Viz jackets
Work gloves

Tree Planting

Spades: For planting

Tree stakes and guards: Get ones that are an appropriate size for your trees and try to source compostable tree guards which are better for the environment

Hedgerow planting

Spades: For planting

String: To mark out the line of the hedge

Canes: To support young saplings

Tree tubes: To protect saplings from browsing by deer and rodents. Try to source compostable tree tube which are better for the environment

Hedgerow cutting

Secateurs: For young hedges

Loppers: For young and mature hedges

Pitch forks: To gather cuttings

Rakes: To clear cuttings

Bow saws: For mature hedges

Note: You may require a local farmer or contractor to cut mature hedges

Hedgelaying

Bill hooks: For laying hedge

Bowsaws: For cutting hedge stems

Loppers: For cutting hedge stems

Rakes: For clearing up/removing cuttings

Pitchforks: For clearing up/removing cuttings

Coppicing

Loppers: For cutting stems

Bowsaws: For cutting stems

Billhooks: For trimming stems

Scrub Clearance


Loppers: For cutting scrub

Bowsaws: For cutting scrub

Fire starting kit: To burn excess cut scrub

Rakes: For clearing cut scrub

Pitchforks: For moving cut scrub
